



## **Facilitators wanted to join a fantastic team of educators!**

One Cumbria are delivering all 6 reformed NPQs in partnership with Teach First. We have 80 Cumbrian colleagues starting their programmes this autumn and are busy recruiting for the second cohort that will start their training in February.

Each programme is facilitated by two colleagues who work as a team, sharing responsibility for preparing to facilitate seminars at the end of module studied online by the programme members. Teach First provide the slide decks and materials and support facilitators with briefing sessions to familiarise them with the approach.

The teams also collaborate to design 2 conference days for their programme members where there is room for creativity and more bespoke training. We organise the conferences and support our facilitators to put together engaging and relevant programmes.

Facilitators are key to our work in that they are helping us to create the local networks of practice and system leadership that will drive improvement in our schools for the benefit of our students. They have access to first rate materials and ideas so that involvement in facilitation is great professional development in its own right.
