The full Induction programme offers schools the chance for Early Career Teachers and their mentors to access a free programme of high-quality CPD and a personalised digital learning platform.

Our team of facilitators from schools within our Teaching School Hub partnership help us to deliver the Year One ECF programme for teachers across the region.

The facilitator role has fantastic benefits of working with schools, teachers and leaders across a wide range of schools and locations. This is an excellent CPD opportunity for anyone wishing to broaden their experiences and to become involved in developing the teaching workforce across our region whilst still working in school.

Facilitators are required to deliver the following programme of events:

- 11 x 90-minute online ECT Seminars after school (max. cohort of 20 / 25 ECTs)
 OR
- 5 x 90-minute online Mentor Seminars after school (max. cohort of 20 / 25 mentors)

Please note all slide decks with notes are provided by Teach First., for each seminar.

In addition, facilitators attend the following:

- 1 hour virtual facilitator training events every half term
- Networking meetings with other facilitators once per half term to share ideas for facilitating training and to provide exemplification from different settings

Quality Assurance

Teach First and One Cumbria have a robust QA process to make sure that facilitation is of the highest quality. This includes observations of delivery and feedback from programme members.

Payment:

The agreed facilitator rate is £45 per hour. This hourly rate is inclusive of travel expenses.

Payments will be made in arrears, termly.
