This is an excellent CPD opportunity for anyone wishing to broaden their experiences and to become involved in developing the teaching workforce across our region whilst still working in school.

Year Two Facilitators are required to attend three half day sessions over the academic year. These will be held during the school day and the monies will be reimbursed direct to your academy/school

and delivering CPD, any coaching experience you may have and how you have worked with colleagues to develop and deepen understanding of teaching and learning
